

Health Strategy in Response to Disclosures of Historical Sexual Abuse

Aim of the strategy

To ensure survivors identified by statutory agencies are able to access appropriate emotional/psychological support from services best suited to their identified needs without hindering or impeding police or legal proceedings.

- To identify health referral pathways for survivors of historical abuse
- To enable survivors to be signposted to the most appropriate service to meet their needs
- To ensure optimum response in cases where complex or significant needs are identified
