	 Learning and Development Sub- Group- Referrer training is ongoing and developing, going forward it will include more detail on Domestic Abuse, Stalking and Harassment and Honour based violence (DASH) forms as part of information gathering. A training reference group was set up to look at the following areas -Causing others to make enquiries, Coercive and controlling behaviour, Self-neglect, Safeguarding Adults Level 3. A programme of training has been developed to cover these areas. Quality Assurance Training Validation Scheme will be further streamlined. Safeguarding Adults Reviews Sub- Group- Coroner referrals- the NSAB chair clarified that he already meets with the coroner on a regular basis. The chair will meet with the SAR sub-group to explore this further to get a better understanding of the issues. Quality Assurance Sub-Group –It was noted referrals into the MASH are more appropriate and this is thought to be due to some good work being undertaken, by all agencies.
