Executive Summary		
Executive Summary	<p>The Clinical Cabinet and Practice Forum met on the 17th October 2017</p> <p>Agenda items and discussion included the following:</p> <p>Finance Update</p> <p>Jonathan Bemrose provided a financial update and comprehensive overview of financial turnaround. Jonathan confirmed that the CCG had declared to NHS England that Control Total would be achieved. Sergio Pappalettera presented the Activity Report and noted a significant reduction in Outpatient First attendances from GP referral. A discussion took place on the increased pressure on the Emergency Department and members were encouraged to use the register in eHealthscope that helped to identify potential care gaps.</p> <p>Care Home Prescribing Update</p> <p>Briony Leighton provided an update on Care Home Prescribing and conformed that £31,212 had been saved through medication reviews during the PEACH study. An update was provided on the audit in relation to SIP Feeds and the ONS Guidelines that had identified that the guidelines were not being followed as stringently as possible and a it was possible for a single patient review to produce savings of £765.</p> <p>Greater Nottingham Community Beds Specification</p> <p>The committee were informed that the specification has been standardised across Greater Nottingham including lengths of stay. A discussion took place around the nursing care that was in place to support the specification.</p> <p>Improving Access to 7 days service in General Practice.</p> <p>Racheal Rees presented an update on the 7 days services in General Practice to the Cabinet and confirmed that the GP Forward View (GPFV) required the CCG to commission an additional 76 working hours across Primary Care in NNE. The CCG would need to have this in place by October 2018. A discussion took place around the potential methods to meet the requirements and a Practice Forum was recommended to allow detailed provider discussions to take place.</p> <p>Update on Federative working</p>	

	<p>Ian Campbell provided an update to the Clinical Cabinet on federative working and detailed progress made in relation to the PICS model, IC confirmed that the model had been discussed and no significant risk or financial outlay had been identified.</p> <p>Greater Nottingham CCG Alignment Update</p> <p>Dr James Hopkinson gave an update to cabinet on the CCG alignment and confirmed that Sam Walters was the Interim Accountable Officer to the Greater Nottingham CCGs. James confirmed that alignment planning was taking place to review committees and sub-committees to streamline across Greater Nottingham.</p> <p>Community Ophthalmology mobilisation update</p> <p>Dr Parm Panesar provided an update on the Clinical Cabinet members on the Community Ophthalmology mobilisation and confirmed that procurement took place and Health Harmonie was the successful bidder with referrals being accepted through e-referrals and results will be available within the next week.</p>
