Chairs Update and Exec Update: These reports were presented to the Board. Working Together 2018: Options papers were presented which outlined the

grant. Further funding options are currently being explored.

suggested options in relation to safeguarding arrangements and Child Death Overview Process (CDOP). Workshops were facilitated to look at **Safeguarding Arrangements** and benefits / risks were discussed. Cross authority issues were raised in relation to the interface between Greater Notts CCGs and the structures being proposed by Local Safeguarding Boards (NSCB / NCSCB). It was identified that the City arrangements are being implemented on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2018. Identified that the proposed **CDOP** alignment would meet the criteria for the recommended number of case reviews. A meeting has been arranged with current CDOP chairs and managers.

- MASH Update: A verbal presentation was received which supported the paper submitted. There was discussion regarding health statistics and it was agreed that future papers should be presented in a multi-agency / partnership approach as this is the model of the MASH. It was identified that the quality of referrals should be reviewed and audited at a multi-agency level and that data should reflect this rather than a single agency focus. Further information should be presented to Board after this process has been completed in order that a more balanced perspective is presented. Other partners to be involved in the process as data within the report are limited to health.
- Ofsted Inspecting Local Authority Children's Services (ILACs) focussed visit
  of care leavers: It was identified that strengths were identified as well as areas for
  improvement. A key finding of this inspection was that caseloads are too high.
- Business Plan: It was requested that this was signed off as a working document.
- **Interim Budget:** Further dialogue required in order to agree how health contribution will be met.
