	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A highlight report from the Safeguarding Assurance Group meeting held on 27 March 2018 was received. This provided assurance in relation to implementation of learning from Serious Case Reviews, implementation of action plans for Child Sexual Exploitation, Domestic Violence (including actions to support raising awareness in primary care) and Neglect, response to consultation on safeguarding adult professionals competency framework and Improving Access to Psychological Therapies (IAPT) provider safeguarding visits.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Safeguarding Committee Annual Report 2017/18 was approved. The Strategic Safeguarding Group Terms of Reference were discussed and are being submitted to Governing Bodies for approval. The Safeguarding Assurance Group Terms of Reference were approved. An update was provided in relation to the Greater Nottingham Clinical Commissioning Partnership with particular emphasis on changes within the safeguarding teams. Discussion took place regarding the future direction of Integrated Care Systems and the implications for safeguarding. An update was provided in relation to the proposed pilot of a Specialist Sexual Violence IAPT service. The option to enable the main provider to enter into partnership arrangements with a specialist provider within the existing financial contract envelope was agreed. An options paper for administrative support for the Designated Nurse Looked After Children was reviewed- it was agreed that administrative support would be provided by the administrative post holders in the Greater Nottingham Quality and Safeguarding Team. Mid Nottinghamshire CCGs administrative team would continue to provide support to the safeguarding group meetings.
