Summary Purpose of Paper:	The following amendments to the terms of reference for the Primary Care Commissioning Committee were received and approved at the Governing Body meeting on 15 January 2019.  • The terms of reference have been developed to be more consistent with the wording from the latest version of the national model terms of reference.  • The proposed membership of the Committee is based on the national primary care commissioning guidance and managing conflicts of interest guidance.  • It is proposed that an independent GP member is included within the Committee's membership in line with the statutory guidance recommendation. This ensures appropriate clinical input, whilst minimising the risk of conflicts of interest, and can be either an out-of-area GP or a recently retired GP. It is proposed that the same individual be appointed to all four committees.  • A GP from the CCG's locality and a representative from the Nottinghamshire Local Medical Committee (LMC) will have a standing invitation to attend meetings, along with the other mandated attendees (i.e. HealthWatch, Health and Wellbeing Board).  • The guidance is clear that the arrangements should not preclude GP participation in strategic discussions on primary care issues. The Committee will have a responsibility to ensure that appropriate GP and member practice engagement has been undertaken when necessary and this will be integral to its decision-making.  • The CCG has certain limitations placed on it in relation to its delegated functions, which need to be kept in mind when decisions are being made. Essentially, any decisions that fall into three specific categories can only be taken following the receipt of prior approval from NHS England and with the involvement of either the Accountable Officer or Chief Finance Officer. These categories relate to:  • Taking any step or action in relation to the settlement of a claim, where
