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Executive Summary

The minutes from the meeting held on 12 October 2017 are not yet ratified and so will follow. Key highlights from the meeting are reported below.

ASSURE

- **Learning and Development Sub- Group-** Referrer training is ongoing and developing, going forward it will include more detail on Domestic Abuse, Stalking and Harassment and Honour based violence (DASH) forms as part of information gathering. A training reference group was set up to look at the following areas -Causing others to make enquiries, Coercive and controlling behaviour, Self-neglect, Safeguarding Adults Level 3. A programme of training has been developed to cover these areas. Quality Assurance Training Validation Scheme will be further streamlined.
- **Safeguarding Adults Reviews Sub- Group-** Coroner referrals- the NSAB chair clarified that he already meets with the coroner on a regular basis. The chair will meet with the SAR sub-group to explore this further to get a better understanding of the issues.
- **Quality Assurance Sub-Group** –It was noted referrals into the MASH are more appropriate and this is thought to be due to some good work being undertaken, by all agencies.
- **NSAB Risk Register-** It was agreed that risks will be identified via the sub-groups and they will monitor these. Alan Breton will take responsibility for identifying the board risks. Members were encouraged to raise any organisational risks in their updates.
- **Learning Disability Mortality Review (LeDeR)-** The work done by the group was brought to the attention of the board. The board approved the proposal for the LeDeR process in Nottinghamshire to report via the Safeguarding Adults Board. It was agreed that the mechanism that the local LeDER area steering group would adopt the function of a sub-group of the SAB.

ADVISE

- **Independent Inquiry into Child Sexual Abuse-** It was noted that in delivering a sensitive service we need to be mindful of the terminology used – survivor rather than victim as we do not want to invoke more distress.
- **EMAS New National Response Times and Standards-** Information shared about the new system in place.
- **Cause to Make Enquiry Update-** NUH are developing a pro-former to help staff to undertake enquiries and are set to do this alongside Nottinghamshire Health Care.
- **Chair’s Report-** Citizens Voices- Leicester City has appointed an engagement officer. On 1st Feb 2018 they will be holding a Making Safeguarding Personal for partners (Workshop) 5 places available - a bid has been put in for a place. Royal College of GPs Safeguarding tool kit available- members of the group advised to view this. Recent high profile modern slavery case in Lincolnshire- table top peer review due to take place, when feedback is available the board will use the learning.
